
## **PHOTO CONTEST**

## Handbook 2000

The most important changes in this years handbook are the re-writing of the chapter "regatta's". The LBJ is now officially sailed under the Pursuit Handicap System. This was actually done for several years, now it is finally also stated in the Handbook.

Several proposals to adjust the Sunday series races, with the object to get more qualifiers, were all voted down by the Executive Race Committee. The Handbook for the year 2000 will leave the Sunday series races essentially as they were last year. So this year will probably have just as many, or as few qualifiers as last year. The biggest change was that the single handed boats have lost their exclusion about flying a protest flag. Finally, after 18 years. (This saves a line, very useful for a Handbook editor)

Now that all these proposals have been discussed and accepted or rejected, it is important that we all adhere to the handbook, and object when we see someone ignoring or changing a rule. If a rule should be changed it should be done in this orderly manner, by discussion and a majority vote.

I thank all the members who sent in comments and proposals for the Handbook. That holds too for the proposals that were not instituted.

## Jet Fleet Report

The Jet Fleet had a good season in 1999 and expects another good season in 2000. This fleet is and was the largest fleet in the Sunday series, and had more qualifiers than all other Sunday Series Fleets together. Only the Wednesday Twilight Series produced more qualifiers.

Rumor has it that there will be a new newly build Mueller Marine Jet joining us this season.

## Wind Dependent Handicaps

The US Sailing wind dependent handicaps for the 2000 sailing season have arrived. Only the Sunfish and Albacore classes had any changes worth mentioning. The Sunfish class underwent the greatest change as there is no recreational rig classification. When comparing the Sunfish Race Rig wind dependent handicaps used in 1999 to the new Sunfish wind dependent handicaps, the class has had time added to its corrected time in each of the wind ranges except for 5-9 beaufort range. For a 45 minute race with a beaufort range of 4, the Sunfish has had about 30 seconds added to its corrected time. No the change was not big, but compare it to about a 20 second reduction in the Albacore's corrected time for the same race duration and wind speed, the Albacore has gained 50 seconds on the Sunfish.

Look for the new wind dependent handicaps in the handbook along with an example of the application formula. The wind dependent handicaps in the handbook are presented based on a boat being rigged to class specifications. An expanded list will be kept on the race committee boat that will include any new classes to the club after publication of the handbook. In addition, wind dependent handicaps will be given for Day Sailers, Jet 14's and Laser II's that do not use spinnakers while racing. It is up to the skipper to advise the race committee that they will not be using a spinnaker when racing in one of these classes during a race in which wind dependent handicaps are to be applied.
